Brecksville Football Code of Conduct 2015

The published rules and regulations of the school and of common sense are accepted as part of the football program. Any infraction of the listed rules could result in removal from the team or other consequences befitting the offense as discussed by the staff.

BRECKSVILLE-BROADVIEW HEIGHTS DISCIPLINARY RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Brecksville Broadview Hts. Football coaching staff has adopted the following policy to help establish rules and regulations for governing team discipline. Team discipline is very important to the daily operation of the football program and will ultimately determine its effectiveness. Our staff believes that football should be a positive learning experience.

Violation of the Disciplinary Rules and Regulations will fall into four categories of disciplinary actions.

- 1. Prohibiting the athlete from practicing.
- 2. Violations left to the discretion of Coach Black and may include extra conditioning after practice.
- 3. Sit out one or more games.
- 4. Dismissal from the team.

Violations that would prohibit an athlete from practicing and participating in games include:

- Failure to maintain eligibility as required by the Brecksville-Broadview Hts. Board of Education and the Ohio High School Athletic Association.
- 2. Failure to turn in proper forms by the date established by the staff.
- 3. Violation of the drug and alcohol policy established by the school district.

Infractions requiring you to participate in extra conditioning would necessitate that you stay after practice and fulfill your obligation.

- 1. Improper dress for game, practice, or team activity.
- 2. Late to practice, game, or team activity.
- 3. Disrespect to coaches, officials, teammates, or opponents.
- 4. Failure to follow training room procedure.
- 5. Horseplay.
- 6. Destruction of school or team property.
- 7. Abusive language
- 8. Any offense that a coach feels is severe enough to destroy team morale or attitude.

Dismissal from the team will result from:

- 1. 3 unexcused absences from practice, team functions or game. It is your responsibility to contact Coach Black if you will not be in attendance. You will be provided with phone numbers to call. You or a parent must call.
- 2. Stealing from the team or teammates.
- 3. Behavior deemed to be hazing/harassment/intimidation.
- 4. Being involved in any form of initiation that is in any way harmful
- 5. Any behavior that would be inappropriate could lead to immediate dismissal

Infractions that would be left to the discretion of Coach Black would include.

- 1. Misconduct during practice, trips, meetings, games or any team function
- 2. Inappropriate behavior towards coaches or teammates.
- 3. Fighting
- 4. The severity of the infraction will determine the degree of punishment.

Infractions regarding the Athletic Contract will be dealt with according to the rules and regulations within the contract. Our coaching staff will adhere to the rules in their entirety.
